

Dear Parent/Carer

I am delighted that your child will be joining us in September and very much look forward to working with you, as a family, to ensure the transition from primary into secondary is as smooth as possible.

There are many unanswered questions around Covid-19, and in particular when schools will reopen. Unfortunately, the pandemic has meant that we have been unable to offer our normal transition programme which includes an introduction day and parents evening. As a school we are committed to doing all we can to ensure that you have all the information you need to assist with «Forename»'s smooth transition from Year 6 to Year 7.

Over the coming weeks and months, we will provide you with additional information and updates and hope that these can go some way to reassuring you, as a family, that Bromfords is the right school for your child.

This letter provides you with details around our school uniform which will help you to start planning and preparing for Year 7.

Skirts and Ties

The Bromfords School and Sixth Form College is the sole supplier of the school tie and the girls skirt and as such they can only be purchased directly from the school via ParentPay at a cost of £6.00 per tie and £21.00 per skirt. You will find your ParentPay details enclosed with this letter. Please note that we require payment to be made no later than 12th June 2020, this is to ensure we have the correct stock available.

Please note that when placing an order, you will be required to enter the number of each item you require and will need to add the required size (skirt only) you wish to purchase prior to payment.
