

Dear Parent/Carer,

We are pleased to be able to inform you that our after-school homework club will recommence from Monday 14<sup>th</sup> September. The club provides a supervised space and the use of computers in the library for students to continue their learning and is particularly popular with many of our younger students. In line with current guidance, we need to maintain the integrity of the year group bubbles, therefore we have had to restrict the access to homework club as follows:

Monday – Year 10 only 3.30pm to 4.30pm

Tuesday – Year 9 only 3.30pm to 4.30pm

Wednesday -Year 7 only 3pm to 4.30pm

Thursday – Year 8 only 3pm to 4.30pm

In addition students will still need to follow the school's hygiene requirements as set out in our risk assessment for classrooms and communal areas and numbers will be restricted with social distancing in place.

Students in Sixth Form will retain access of the Sixth Form Study area until 4.15pm and students in Year 11 will be offered after school sessions across subject areas, some of which we aim to have running from next week. Year 11 students should initially speak to their class teacher for further information. Going forward, we will keep the running of homework club under constant review.
