Police officers keep law and order, investigate crime, and support crime prevention.



£21,000 - £41,500 a year



Working 37 - 40 hours per week



You could take a Level 2 or 3 Diploma in Public Services before applying to the police, although this is not essential. Every force sets their own entry requirements but usually you will need 4 or 5 GCSEs at grades 9 to 4 (A* to C) including Maths and English. You could start by doing a police constable degree apprenticeship. You could volunteer as a special constable or paid work as a police community support officer.

Astronauts fly spacecraft and do experiments in space.



£40,000 - £80,000 per year



Working 39 - 41 hours per week



You can apply for astronaut training with the European Astronaut Corps or with NASA. You need to be between 27 and 37 years old and able to speak English fluently. It'll be helpful if you can speak basic Russian because it's used along with English on the International Space Station. You'll have an advantage if you're a pilot with at least 1,000 hours of flying experience in a high performance aircraft like a fighter jet. You'll also need a **degree** and a **postgraduate qualification** in a relevant subject like; biology, chemistry, physics, aeronautics or engineering.

Museum Curator



£20,000 – £40,000



38–40 hours per week on a rota, often including weekends

You'll usually need a degree and a postgraduate or professional qualification relevant to your area of interest to become a curator. Subjects include museum or heritage studies, archaeology or ancient history, classics, natural sciences, anthropology, or education.



Paid or unpaid work experience in a museum, gallery or heritage property is usually essential to apply for courses and jobs.

You could work as an assistant curator, conservator or education manager before becoming a museum curator, or you may be able to start by doing an advanced apprenticeship in heritage and cultural operations.

39-41 hours per week

You will usually need a degree in physics, applied physics, or a related science or engineering subject.



You may also need a relevant postgraduate qualification, like a master's degree or PhD. These courses include more independent research and lead directly onto further postgraduate study like a PhD.

You may be able to do a 1-year physics foundation course before your degree, if you do not have a background in science.

£15,000 – £60,000 per year



39–41 hours a week, usually irregular hours

You'll need a degree and postgraduate qualification to work as an astronomer. Your degree will usually need to be a first or upper second-class. Relevant subjects include maths, physics, astrophysics, geophysics, astronomy and space science.



You can also do an extended 4-year degree to get a postgraduate qualification like a master of physics. Many employers will expect you to have completed, or be working towards, a PhD in your specialist area of interest.
