Our Sixth Form has a track record of success with a consistent improvement to student outcomes seen over recent years. Over 45% of A Level grades achieved by students are at A* to B. We offer a high-quality post-16 education with a wide range of A Levels and Vocational (Level 3) qualifications. We have a quiet study area as well as two break-out computer rooms for independent or peer work.

We have a Student Leadership Team which plays an important part for the whole school, who work closely with Student Voice.

We pride ourselves on encouraging every

student to maximise their full potential and have high expectations for all of our students, which, together with the support and pastoral care available, allows all of our Sixth Form cohort to be successful and be fully prepared for their next steps and future destinations.

In 2022, our students progressed to destinations including degree courses in Biology, Engineering, Teaching and Game Design and apprenticeships at Ernest Young and Willis Towers Watson and Network Rail.

Enrichment

Our Sixth Form are actively encouraged to organise and take part in whole school fundraising and extra-curricular events, such as our school productions and assisting in our sports events with local primary schools. Students are encouraged to develop their leadership skills through presenting assemblies, both to the main school and Sixth Form and mentoring younger students. Students are also able to take part in Gold Duke of Edinburgh Award with a number of students receiving their awards at Buckingham Palace.

Next Steps

A key part of our Sixth Form is preparing students to make successful applications for their future careers and studies. We have successfully supported students into competitive apprenticeships at Lloyds, PwC, Willis Towers Watson and BT among others. Our students have also gone on to a range of Universities including Cambridge, Exeter, Southampton and Queen Mary.

Our students have multiple opportunities whilst in Sixth Form to engage with a variety of Apprenticeship providers and Universities, as well as undertaking a week of work experience at the end of Year 12, in line with the Baker Clause and Gatsby Benchmarks.

Students make use of our links with organisations like Career Ready to gain insights into industries that they may wish to move into, with mentoring and work experience opportunities offered.



Pastoral Support

All students have the support they need to help them fully engage in their education. Our pastoral team are highly skilled which include tutors, pastoral manager and the Head of Sixth Form. If students have any issues or problems, staff are on hand to listen and offer helpful advice. Our pastoral programme also explores themes such as coping with exam stress, keeping healthy, becoming resilient and preparing for future life plans.

We have a very strong and valuable Leadership Team within the Sixth Form that is made up of four students who are elected by their peers. Each Leader has a focus they are passionate about and are involved in regular meetings with the student council representatives from each year group. The Leadership Team allows us to amplify the student voice, ensuring that all pupils feel valued and represented at school.
