REWARD CERTIFICATES AND BADGES

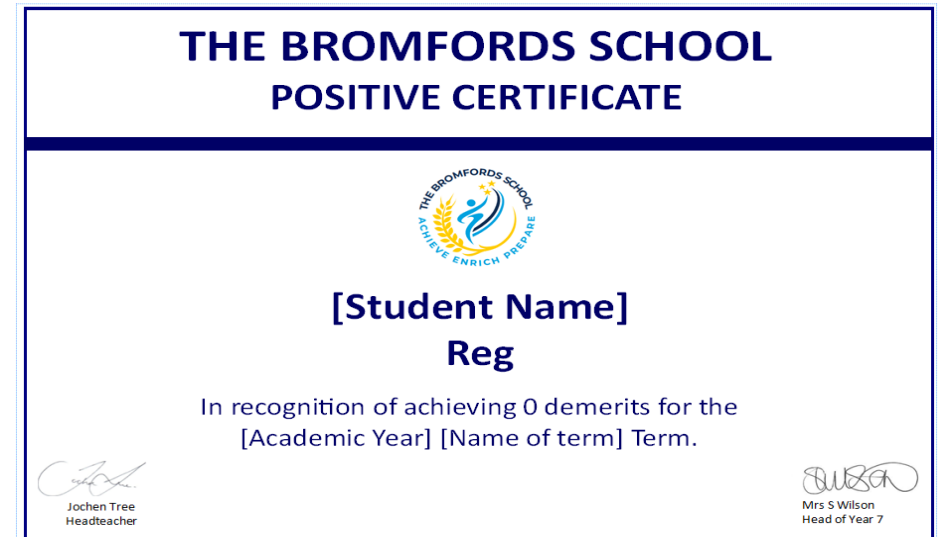
Students are awarded a **star badge** and **certificate** termly by their **Head of Year** for:

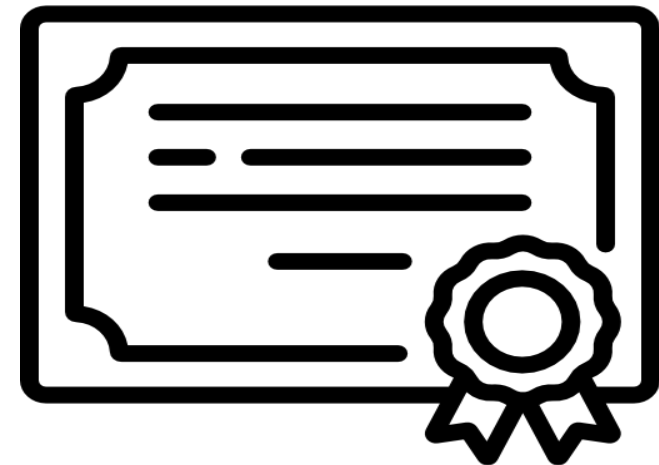
Our Community Reward System
